An Act relative to the theft of copper wire.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 142 of chapter 266 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 8, by striking out the words “fifty dollars” and  
3 inserting in place thereof the following words:- “five hundred dollars for each instance”
