An Act increasing penalties for overserving alcohol.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 69 of chapter 138, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting, after the first sentence, the following:-

3 Whoever violates this section shall be punished, for a first offense, by a fine of not less  
4 than two hundred and fifty dollars nor more than one thousand dollars, or by imprisonment for  
5 not less than one month nor more than six months, or both; for a second or subsequent offense,  
6 by a fine of not less than one thousand dollars nor more than two thousand five hundred dollars,  
7 or by imprisonment for not less than six months nor more one year, or both.
