## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relating to a certain parcel of land in Charlestown.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the
- 2 contrary, a certain parcel of land located at 425 Medford street in the Charlestown section of the
- 3 city of Boston shall not be included within the boundaries of any designated port area, except for
- 4 the area consisting of approximately 5.47 acres described as "Maritime Area" on a plan entitled
- 5 "Exhibit Plan of Land Maritime Area," dated May 29, 2013 prepared by Kelly Engineering
- 6 Group, Inc. Said certain parcel of land is located at 425 Medford Street in the Charlestown
- 7 section of the City of Boston, assessor's parcel numbers 0201799000 and 0201798000,
- 8 containing approximately 839,808 square feet and 48,965 square feet of land and water and is
- 9 recorded at Book 621, page179 in the Suffolk county registry of deeds.
