An Act authorizing a memorandum of agreement between the Massachusetts State Police and the Boston Police Department.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The first sentence of section 110 of chapter 205 of the acts of 1996 is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following words:-

3           provided, however, that the department of the state police may enter into a memorandum  
4 of understanding with the Boston police department regarding jurisdiction over that airport and  
5 other Massachusetts Port Authority properties located in the city of Boston, which may include,  
6 but shall not be limited to, procedures involving: (i) assignment of officers; (ii) first responder  
7 calls and E911 dispatch; (iii) emergencies occurring on Massachusetts Port Authority properties;  
8 (iv) criminal investigations of incidents and crimes; (v) arrests and processing of individuals  
9 taken into custody; and (vi) optimal methods of community policing.
