In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act eliminating Form 901 reporting requirement.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 15A of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out section 15C and inserting in place thereof the following section:-
- 3 "Section 15C. Each institution within the system of public higher education shall
- 4 annually produce audited financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting
- 5 principles, generally accepted auditing standards, and generally accepted governmental auditing
- 6 standards. The statements shall be in accordance with procedures for timeliness and for
- 7 disclosures as proscribed by the office of the state comptroller and approved by the state auditor.
- 8 The statements shall include all expenditures and revenues from all appropriated and non-
- 9 appropriated funds and be filed with the governor, office of state comptroller, the board of higher

- education, the house and senate committees on ways and means, and the joint committee on
- higher education no later than October 15 each year."
