In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to accessory apartments.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, or regulation to the contrary, a 2 municipality that adopts a zoning ordinance or by-law to allow the construction of accessory 3 apartments shall be permitted to count accessory apartment units toward that municipality's 4 subsidized housing inventory so long as the occupant meets the income-eligibility standards 5 determined by the federal Department of Housing and Urban Development; and provided further 6 that evidence of income verification is provided to the department of housing and community 7 development upon issuance of a building permit for the accessory apartment and annually 8 thereafter; and provided further that said accessory apartments shall not be required to be subject 9 to the provisions of the affirmative marketing plan, including the prohibition against renting to 10 family members and relatives; and provided further that accessory apartments shall not be 11 subject to deed restrictions.

- For the purposes of this section, an accessory apartment shall be defined as an additional,
- separate, but connected dwelling unit, which contains facilities for living, sleeping, eating,
- 14 cooking, and sanitation, that has been constructed onto an owner-occupied single-family home.
