In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)

An Act relative to ensuring housing benefits for veterans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1: notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the executive office
- 2 of housing and economic development shall require all recipients or any person seeking housing
- 3 or assistance in any form, including vouchers, to provide a valid social security number and the
- 4 housing agency is required to verify the number.
