## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to redevelopment authority vacancies.

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Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- The fourth paragraph of section 5 of chapter 121B, as appearing in the 2012 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-
- Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, if the department does not fill
- 4 a vacancy within 150 days from the date that a vacancy is created, or within 120 days that one or
- 5 more individuals applies for the position, provided that it does not exceed 150 days, the board of
- 6 selectmen in combination with the current members of the redevelopment authority by a majority
- vote, or in a city, the mayor with the confirmation of the city council, will appoint a person to fill
- 8 such vacancy for the unexpired portion of the term.
