In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to the safety of newborns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 39 1/2 of chapter 119 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 3 and 4, inclusive, the words "or
3	manned fire station" and inserting in place thereof the following:-, manned fire station or with
4	an emergency responder at an agreed upon location following a 911 call

6	SECTION 2. Section 39 1/2 of said chapter 119, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
7	striking, in line 6, in the first instance in which it appears, the word "an" and inserting in place
8	thereof the following:- and

11	striking out, in lines 16 and 17, inclusive, the words "hospital, police department or manned fire
12	station" and inserting in place thereof the following:- designated facility
