An Act relative to leasing of residential property.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 15B of chapter 186 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-

3 (10) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any term of a lease or rental  
4 agreement which is less than 365 days and if the residential property is the homeowner’s primary  
5 residence.
