Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1: Section 13D of Chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby amended by	
2	striking out the words: "shall be punished by imprisonment in the house of correction for not less	
3	than 90 days nor more than 2 and one-half years" and inserting in place thereof the following	
4	words "shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than 2 and one-half years in a jail or	
5	house of correction or for not more than 10 years in a state prison"	
6	SECTION 2: Section 13D of Chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby amended by	
7	inserting after the first paragraph the following paragraph: "For the purposes of this section,	
8	"bodily substance" shall mean any human secretion, discharge or emission including, but not	
9	limited to, blood, saliva, mucous, semen, urine or feces."	
10	SECTION 3: Section 13D of Chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby amended by	
11	inserting after the second paragraph: Whoever commits an assault or an assault and battery by	
12	means of a bodily substance on any public employee when such person is engaged in the	

- 13 performance of his duties at the time of such assault and battery, shall be punished by
- 14 imprisonment for not more than 2 and one-half years in a jail or house of correction or for not
- 15 more than 10 years in a state prison or by a fine of not less than \$500 nor more than \$5,000, or
- 16 both.
