An Act regarding assistant court clerks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

2 is hereby amended by striking the words “Plymouth, 6 assistant clerks” and inserting in place
3 thereof the following: “Plymouth, 10 assistant clerks”
