An Act relative to filing fees for appeals of civil motor vehicle infractions.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph (4) of subsection (A) of section 3 of chapter 90C of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the sixth paragraph  
3 the following paragraph:-

4 The \$25 court filing fee shall be returned to the petitioner if the magistrate or justice  
5 enters a finding of not responsible.
