An Act relative to justices of the peace.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 15 of Chapter 9 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended, in line 3, by striking out the word “thirty” and inserting in place thereof the  
3 figures “90”, and by striking out the word “fourteen” and inserting in place thereof the figure  
4 “75”.
