**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to the advisory committee on personnel standards.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of Chapter 211B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the first paragraph and inserting in its place the
3 following: --

4 “There shall be an advisory committee on personnel standards. The membership of the
5 committee shall consist of the following persons: the chief justice for administration and
6 management or his designee who shall serve as chair of the committee, the chief justices of the
7 trial court departments, three (3) clerk of courts appointed by the superior court clerks
8 association, three (3) district court clerks appointed by the district court clerks association, three
9 (3) reregisters of probate, three (3) Juvenile Clerk Magistrates and the commissioner of
10 probation.”
