## In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act expanding protections against incest.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 17 of chapter 272 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "consanguinity", in line 1 , the following words:- , affinity or adoption.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
