An Act relative to the Sex Offender Registry.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 178 of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

3 The Sex Offender Registry Board shall classify a convicted sex offender and make a  
4 ruling on said offender’s appeal prior to release from sentence within sufficient time to give said  
5 offender an appeal of said classification. The Sex Offender Registry Board must alert all sex  
6 offenders of their classification and appellate rights within sufficient time to give said sex  
7 offender an appeal of said classification prior to release from sentence.
