In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)

An Act creating the crime of larceny by overcoming a security device.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 266 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the
2 following section:

3 Section 148. Any person who, with intent to steal property from any store or other retail
4 mercantile establishment, knowingly possesses any item, article, implement or device designed
5 for the purpose of overcoming detection of security markings or attachments placed on any
6 property offered for sale at such store or establishment shall be punished by imprisonment in jail
7 for not more than two years or by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars, or by both such
8 fine and imprisonment.
