**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to the repeal of certain archaic laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 16A of Chapter 264 of the General Laws, is hereby repealed.
- 2 SECTION 2. Section 34 of Chapter 265 of the General Laws, is hereby repealed.
- 3 SECTION 3. Section 14 of Chapter 272 of the General Laws, is hereby repealed.
- 4 SECTION 4. Section 18 of Chapter 272 of the General Laws, is hereby repealed.
- 5 SECTION 5. Section 26 of Chapter 272 of the General Laws, is hereby repealed.
- 6 SECTION 6. Section 36 of Chapter 272 of the General Laws, is hereby repealed.
