An Act to increase public knowledge of foreclosures.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 14 of chapter 244 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting in the first  
2 paragraph after the words “or in a newspaper with general circulation in the city or town where  
3 the land lies” the following language:

4           "and notice of the sale has been recorded in the registry of deeds for the county or district  
5 where the land lies at least 14 days prior to the date of sale"
