An Act relative to issuing citations to motor vehicle moving violations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1.

2           Section 2 of chapter 90C, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended  
3 by inserting, after the word “records” in line 83, the following new sentence:-

4           Provided, however, a motor vehicle civil citation issued pursuant to a moving violation,  
5 as defined in section 113B of chapter 175 of the General Laws, may not be mailed to the alleged  
6 violator but shall be manually delivered to said alleged violator either at the time of the alleged  
7 violation or at the time such citation was recorded.
