By Mr. Carvalho of Boston, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 161) of Evandro C. Carvalho and others for legislation to modernize the business licensing process. Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure.

The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act modernizing the business licensing process.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "antemeridian", in lines 130, and
- 3 in line 134, the second time it appears the following words:-, except in a city or town that is
- 4 serviced by the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority as authorized by chapter 161A if
- 5 the local governing body of such city or town accepts this provision.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 2 of chapter 140 as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition is hereby
- 7 amended by adding the following paragraph: -
- 8 "Licensing authorities, at their discretion and subject to local licensing rules and
- 9 regulations, may exempt all innholders and common victuallers that do not serve alcoholic
- beverages from the licensing requirements of this section."

11	SECTION 3. Section 177A of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
12	Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence of the first paragraph the
13	following sentence: -
14	"Notwithstanding the requirements of this section, the licensing authority in any city or
15	town shall have the authority to exempt all automatic amusement devices from licensing
16	requirements under this section."
17	SECTION 4. Section 177 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
18	amended by inserting after the first sentence of the first paragraph the following sentence: -
19	"Notwithstanding the requirements of this section, the licensing authority in any city or
20	town shall have the authority to exempt any person who keeps such billiard, pool, or sippio table
21	or bowling alley from the licensure requirements of this section."
22	SECTION 5. Section 181 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
23	amended by adding the following paragraph:
24	"The Mayor or Selectmen, at their discretion and subject to local licensing rules and
25	regulations, may set a maximum capacity for all establishments, under which the licensing
26	requirements of this section shall not apply."
27	SECTION 6. Section 183A of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is
28	hereby amended by inserting after the first paragraph the following paragraph: -
29	"Licensing authorities, at their discretion and subject to local licensing rules and
30	regulations may set a maximum capacity for all establishments, under which the licensing
31	requirements of this section shall not apply."

32 SECTION 7. Section 185I of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is 33 hereby amended by adding the following sentence: -

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"Notwithstanding the requirements of this section, the local licensing authorities in any city or town shall have the authority to exempt all fortune tellers from licensure required by this section."
