Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1: Chapter 151 of the General Laws, section 1A, is hereby amended by

- 8 accumulated periods, not in excess of one hundred seventy days in any one year.
