## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to state lottery agents.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 24 of Chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word sold in line 25, the following:-, provided,
- 3 however, the commission paid to licensed sales agents for the sale of tickets produced on official
- 4 paper stock in an authorized manner from the Lottery's on-line computer system and from
- 5 instant games shall not be less than five and one-half per cent.
