**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act regulating Chapter 136.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 16 of chapter 136 is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the sentence "the
2 performance of labor, business and work directly connected to retail sales on these days shall
3 also be allowed" the following:

4 and the provisions of clause (50) of section six of chapter one hundred and thirty six
5 pertaining to voluntariness of work and time and one half payments shall apply to these
6 employees.
