In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act further regulating workers' compensation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 22 of chapter 152 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-
- 3 Failure to give such written notice of coverage or cancellation shall be punishable by fine
- 4 of not less than \$50 not more than \$100 per day.
