An Act An act allowing the town of Westborough to adopt certain alcoholic beverage licensure laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding sections 17A and 17B of chapter 138 of the General Laws, requiring a  
2   city or town to accept the provisions of said sections on or before June 30, 1984, or the provision  
3   of section 17C of said chapter 138, requiring a city or town to accept the provisions of said  
4   section 17A on or before January 1, 1985, the town of Westborough may, at a vote of town  
5   meeting, accept the provisions of said sections 17A to 17C, inclusive, of said chapter 138.
