An Act relative to the Nantucket Memorial Airport Fuel Revolving Account.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Chapter 28 of the acts of 2004 is hereby amended by inserting at the end of  
2 section 1 the following: This fund shall not be included in the calculation of the aggregate limit  
3 of all revolving funds authorized under section 53E1/2 of said chapter 44.

4           Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage
