**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act maintaining confidentiality of proprietary information within health care oversight agencies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of section 11 of Chapter 6D of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by Chapter 224 of the Acts of 2012, is hereby amended by adding after the
3 fourth sentence in this subsection the following 3 sentences: -

4 The commission shall keep confidential all nonpublic data obtained under this section
5 and shall not disclose the data to any person without the consent of the provider or payer that
6 produced the data, except in a preliminary report or final report under this section if the
7 commission believes that such disclosure should be made in the public interest after taking into
8 account any privacy, trade secret or anti-competitive considerations. The confidential data shall
9 not be public records and shall be exempt from disclosure under clause Twenty-sixth of section 7
10 of chapter 4 or section 10 of chapter 66.

11 SECTION 2. Subsection (a) of section 9 of chapter 12C of the General Laws, as so
12 appearing, shall be amended by inserting after the last sentence the following:-

13 The center shall keep confidential all nonpublic data obtained under this section and shall
14 not disclose the data to any person without the consent of the provider or payer that produced the
15 data, except in a preliminary report or final report under this section if the center believes that
16 such disclosure should be made in the public interest after taking into account any privacy, trade
17 secret or anti-competitive considerations. The confidential data shall not be public records and
18 shall be exempt from disclosure under clause Twenty-sixth of section 7 of chapter 4 or section 10
19 of chapter 66.

20 SECTION 3. Subsection (c) of section 3 of chapter 176T of the General Laws, as so
21 appearing, shall be amended by inserting after the first sentence the following:-

22 The division shall keep confidential all nonpublic information obtained under this section
23 and shall not disclose the information to any person without the consent of the provider or payer
24 that produced the information, except in a preliminary report or final report under this section if
25 the division believes that such disclosure should be made in the public interest after taking into
26 account any privacy, trade secret or anti-competitive considerations. The confidential
27 information shall not be public records and shall be exempt from disclosure under clause
28 Twenty-sixth of section 7 of chapter 4 or section 10 of chapter 66.
