## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act requiring pain assessment and management in healthcare facilities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 70E of Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding after subsection (o) the following new

3 subsection:-

4 (p) to prompt assessment, management and treatment of his or her pain that respects the

5 patient's individual needs and to periodic reassessment and modification of the pain management

6 plan, if necessary.
