An Act expanding eligibility for the Massachusetts loan repayment program for dental providers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: Notwithstanding any law to the contrary any dental provider practicing in  
2 the Commonwealth and who works for a non-profit that has documented that over 50% of  
3 patients served are Mass Health and/or Medicaid eligible shall be eligible to access the  
4 Massachusetts Loan Repayment Program offered by the Department of Public Health.
