**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act to jet ski safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 9B of Chapter 90B of the General Laws as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition
2 is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence in line 4 and inserting in place thereof the
3 following sentence:-

4 All persons who operate a jet ski, surf jet or wetbikes shall be required to participate in a
5 regulated mandatory training program before operating such watercraft; provided, however, that
6 the director of said division shall establish the program criteria and content and shall determine
7 the minimum safety skills necessary for said persons to operate such watercraft.
