An Act relative to the disclosure of certain police reports.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 97D of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the following sentence:- The police
- 3 department shall notify the victim if it receives any written request for the victim's report.
