**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act An act amending the periodic inspections of elevators and lifts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 64 of chapter 143 of the General Laws, as amended by section 16 of chapter 36
2 of the Acts of 2012, is hereby amended by inserting after the words, “whether attached or
3 detached”, the following words:- “, and elevators of less than 20 vertical feet, not including
4 material lifts”.
