Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of Chapter 269 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition
2 is hereby amended, in line 160 by inserting after the words "law enforcement officer" the words
3 ", or a retired law enforcement officer who meets the requirements of 501 CMR 13.02"
