An Act concerning public safety personnel residency.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: Section 99A of Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended in the  
2 first sentence by inserting at the end thereof the following words:--

3           “or such greater distance as is specified in a city or town charter, or as provided in a by-  
4 law adopted by the Town Meeting, based on the affirmative recommendation of the Board of  
5 Selectmen, or an ordinance adopted by the City Council, based on the affirmative  
6 recommendation of the Mayor.”
