Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any General, Special Law or Provision of any law or rule to the

2 contrary, that any member of the Professional Fire Fighters of Massachusetts who while during

3 the solicitation of donations to such a worthy cause may do so in his/her uniform while on duty.
