An Act relative to retirement benefits for Massachusetts housing authority electricians.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "managers;" in line 291 the  
3 following:- "Licensed Electricians employed at the Massachusetts housing authorities governed  
4 by MGL 121b Section 3 and 3a;"
