An Act relative to retired capitol police officers disabled in the performance of duty.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Section 90A of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as amended by section 2 of chapter 177
- 2   of the Acts of 1997, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word “officer”, in line 15,
- 3   the following words:— or, capitol police officer.
