Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 2 official edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "corporation", in line 15, the
- 3 following words:- ;provided further, that the provisions of this chapter shall not apply to charities
- 4 and non-profits that obtain approval from the local licensing authority to purchase and distribute
- 5 certain limited quantities of alcohol from retail package stores for the purpose of hosting
- 6 fundraisers.
