In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)

An Act relative to Commonwealth employees taking public higher education courses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Active employees of the Commonwealth with over five years of state
- 2      employment will be allowed to take courses on a space available basis at any state college or
- 3      public university with a reduction in cost of fifty percent on tuition and fees.
