An Act to improve fairness and uniformity in real estate transactions.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 184 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:

2 SECTION 8B. UNIFORM REPORTING OF SQUARE FOOTAGE IN RESIDENTIAL  
3 REAL ESTATE TRANSACTIONS

4 For any sale or transaction of residential or commercial real estate in the commonwealth,  
5 the gross square footage of the residential unit or units involved in the transaction shall be  
6 calculated according to the following rubric: the gross square footage of any relevant building or  
7 structure shall include the sum total of the floor areas for all floor levels, basements and sub-  
8 basements, measured from the inside walls, irrespective of the existence of interior fire resistive  
9 walls, floors, and ceilings.
