An Act Relative to Municipal Employees Premium Contribution Rate.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 32B of the General Laws, is hereby amended by  
2 inserting in the definition of “employee” in Line 68, the following:--

3 For employees who work less than full time, as defined by the employer, the employer’s  
4 premium contribution rate shall be pro-rated based on the number of hours worked.
