An Act relative to the State Retiree Benefits Trust Fund Board of Directors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (d) of section 4 of chapter 29D of the General Laws, as  
2   appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 26, the words  
3   “7 trustees” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- 8 trustees

4           SECTION 2. Said subsection (d) of said section 4 of said chapter 29D, as so appearing, is  
5   hereby further amended by striking out, in line 31, the number “2” and inserting in place thereof  
6   the following number:- 3

7           SECTION 3. Said subsection (d) of said section 4 of said chapter 29D, as so appearing, is  
8   hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 31 and 32, the words “1 of whom shall be  
9   appointed by the governor and 1 of whom shall be appointed by the state treasurer” and inserting  
10   in place thereof the following words:- 1 of whom shall be appointed by the governor, 1 of whom  
11   shall be appointed by the state treasurer and 1 of whom shall be appointed by the Massachusetts  
12   Municipal Association
