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An Act relative to retirement benefits for care givers at the soldier's homes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1: Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2012 Official  
2           edition is hereby amended by inserting after the phrase "duties assigned to them" in line 248 the  
3           following:- "employees of Holyoke and Chelsea Soldiers' Homes employed as licensed Practical  
4           Nurses, Certified Nursing Assistants, Recreational Therapist and physical therapy assistants;"
