An Act relative to National Guard benefits.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 4h of chapter 32 of the General Laws of the 2012 Official Edition is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after line 160 the following sentence:-

3           “Any member of the National Guard or Active Reserve that has served a minimum of  
4 twenty years shall be eligible for state pension benefits regardless of the type of service  
5 performed.”
