An Act relative to military state income tax exemption.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Clause (2) of subsection (a) of section 2 of chapter 62 of the General Laws,  
2   as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after subclause (Q),  
3   the following new subclause:-

4           (R) Any wages received from the United States government by a Massachusetts resident  
5   who is a member of the United States military and serving on active duty no matter where based.
