An Act relative to the taxation of rolling stock.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 64H, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting, after the definition of “Retail establishment”, the following new  
3 definition:-

4           “Rolling stock”, vehicles such as trucks, tractors, trailers, and railcars that transport  
5 people or goods in interstate commerce.

6           SECTION 2. Section 6 of Chapter 64H, as most recently amended by chapter 165 of the  
7 acts of 2014, is hereby further amended by inserting, after subsection (xx), the following new  
8 subsection:

9           “(yy) sales of rolling stock”

10           SECTION 3. Section 1 of Chapter 64I, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is  
11 amended by inserting in line 6, after the words “ retail sale”, the following new words:- “rolling  
12 stock”, .

13           SECTION 4. Section 7 of chapter 64I of the general laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
14 amended by inserting, after subsection (e), the following new subsection:-

15           “(f) storage, use or other consumption of rolling stock”.
