In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act updating non-taxable medical supplies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Paragraph (1) of
- 2 Section 6 of Chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is
- 3 hereby amended by adding, in line 12, after the word "lifts," the following words:
- 4 "infusion pumps used to deliver drugs to patients who require intravenous fluids,
- 5 antibiotics, chemotherapy, pain management, blood products, biotechnology agents and any
- 6 other intravenous infusions ordered by a physician and related disposables including
- 7 administration sets, extension sets, filters, needle-less connectors, sterile covers,
- 8 syringes/needles, alcohol wipes, gloves, tape, and sharps containers; central venous catheters,
- 9 peripherally inserted central catheters, ports or peripheral intravenous catheters, central venous
- dressing kits, venous access device kits, Huber needles, and securing devices; continuous

- positive airway pressure (CPAP) and Bi-level positive airway pressure (BIPAP) supplies,
- 12 including tubing, headgear, nasal masks, full masks, and filters; suction machines used in the
- care of a patient's tracheostomy, including suction canisters, suction connecting tubing, suction
- catheters, trach care kits, peroxide, sterile sponges, sterile q-tips, and gloves; and other durable
- medical equipment, including bathroom commodes, nebulizers, and aerosol-generating devices."
