An Act relative to the taxation of state pensions.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: The first paragraph of section 19 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as  
2   appearing on the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second sentence  
3   the following sentence:-

4           "The exemption from income taxes levied under chapter 62 shall be applicable to the first  
5   \$50,000 annually".

6           SECTION 2: This act shall take effect upon passage.
